- A clinical and medical team working in conjunction with the resident's current Primary Care Provider and/or Endocrinologist and reporting 'any change in condition'
- Materials and resources certified by AMDA which includes a diabetic tool kit with policies and procedures for Assisted Living
- Nursing services provided 7 days a week
