Along with our partners in Assisted as well as Independent Living communities, we have implemented the most evolved, comprehensive and integrated ‘medical model’ of on-site support and training developed to date.

Hampton Health has pioneered these novel business methods which are licensed and implemented through our intellectual property subsidiary known as "Physician Assisted Living Solutions" (PALS™).

Traditionally, assisted living communities were built upon a ‘social model’, addressing social issues such as isolation, prepared meals, and manageable living spaces.

As our older population has continued to grow and age, we have witnessed first-hand the increasing importance for the addition of a ‘medical model’ to address complications of aging, medical issues and illnesses that affect our elders and chronically ill individuals, as well as the need to address the critical issue of adult children of aging parents ‘caregiver strain’ within our assisted living communities.

Putting his innovative medical methods into practice, Dr. Fullerton and the Hampton Health team of geriatric-trained providers work closely with patients and their families to provide comprehensive care by promoting targeted healthcare screening and age-related disease monitoring and management, with an emphasis on a personalized and individualized approach to enhancing quality of life.



As a geriatric specialty practice Hampton Health serves as the centralized point of contact for access to other healthcare and wellness specialists and work closely with them as part of a multi-disciplinary team.

The primary goal of Hampton Health is to provide wellness and preventative care within Assisted and Independent Living communities in an effort to avoid the transfer and trauma that comes from unnecessary visits to the ER or hospital.

Some of the specific services we offer:

- Personalized and accessible services that provide ongoing monitoring for chronic illnesses and changes in condition 24/7.
- Coordination, streamlining and management of patient medication, diet and physical therapy, by working closely with caregivers, management and community staff.
- Open communication with designated family members and care givers, employing family care conferences and/or conferences with staff, and assisting patients and families with the creation of advanced directives for care.
- Providing access to premiere local resources including homecare, hospitalist care, skilled nursing facility care and rehabilitation, estate and elder law assistance, case managers and medical social workers/counselors, geropsychiatrists, neurophysiologists, certified geriatric advisors, and local sub-specialty consultants (for referrals).
- Our geriatric-trained Certified Physician Assistants (PA-C's) and Stanford PA Students (under the supervision of Dr. Fullerton and wife Kate McElroy Fullerton, PA-C) assist in the medical evaluation of patients and alternate seeing patients with Dr. Fullerton.
- Our medical assistants are trained for on-site EKG testing, vaccinations, ear lavage (irrigations), phlebotomy (blood draws), tuberculosis testing (and other "CLIA Waived" lab tests), MMSE (mental status testing) and Geriatric Depression Assessment, as well as assistance with RCFE forms (Physician's Report for Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly), Department of Motor Vehicle and Long Term Care Insurance forms.
